

And finally:-. The Octave day of the Easter Season has, since the Pontificate of Pope St. John Paul II, been known as 'Divine Mercy Sunday'. Today as we gather, bathed in the light of Easter glory, we rejoice in the wonderful gift of God's mercy revealed in Christ. The power of Christ's Resurrection, John Paul II wrote, "heals the wounds of the heart, pulls down the barriers that separate us from God and divide us from one another, and at the same time, restores the joy of the Father's love and of fraternal unity." The challenge for us, of course, is that we are called not only to receive the mercy that comes to us from God, but also to practice mercy towards others. Today, in so many parts of our world, and even in our own families, we see the devastating effects of hatred and division, places where mercy finds no home. Today let us pray that the power of the Cross, which brought healing and reconciliation into our broken world, may move the hearts and minds of all peoples to be merciful.
