Key Facts

- Through listening, Samuel was able to hear God speaking to him.
- The second part of the Mass is called the Liturgy of the Word. This is an important time in the Mass when God's family listens to God speaking to them in the scripture readings.
- The first reading in Mass usually comes from the Old Testament, the responsorial psalm is a song from the Book of Psalms and the second reading at Mass comes from the New Testament.
