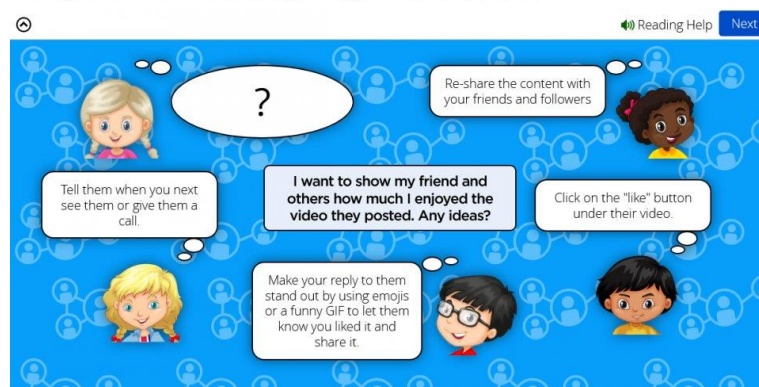
Expectations

- Online safety lessons at St Mary of the Angels are taught using Project evolve, a digital education toolkit which prepares learners for the digital world.
- Year groups will focus on a different strand each half term.

Term	Strand to be assessed and taught
Autumn 1 - Induction week	Privacy and security Online bullying
Autumn 2	Health, wellbeing and lifestyle
Spring 1	Online reputation
Spring 2	Self-image & identity
Summer 1	Managing online information
Summer 2	Copyright & ownership Online relationships

- Each class starts a strand by completing a knowledge map. Knowledge maps offer students a variety of scenarios about their online lives and provide a set of responses that are carefully mapped against the Burch Competency Framework. This enables our class teachers to categorise children's understanding of a concept; whether it is secure, emerging, developing, if they are unsure or if they have understood the concept incorrectly.

- The results from the key knowledge map then determine the objectives which need to be covered over the half term.
- At the end of the half term, children are reassessed with a final knowledge map so that any progress and impact of the teaching that has taken place can be identified.
- Ten:Ten resources will be used to teach the online relationships strand. These objectives are broken down even further in Project Evolve with resources to help staff in Summer 2.
