Key Facts

- These are the names of the twelve disciples: Simon (who Jesus liked to call Peter, which means rock), his brother Andrew; brothers James and John; Philip and Bartholomew; Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James and Thaddaeus; Simon and Judas Iscariot, who would later betray him.
- The Apostles of Jesus were sent out after Pentecost to preach the Good News of the Resurrection.
- The Apostles and the first followers of Jesus shared their lives together.
- Paul went on three important journeys to preach the Good News about the Resurrection of Christ.
