The Rite of Reconciliation

Welcome and introduction by the priest.
Confessing of sins.

The priest talks to us and tries to help us so that we can follow Jesus.

We receive a penance - a prayer and maybe some other action as an act of thanksgiving for God's forgiveness.


We pray an act of contrition.
