Dear Parents,

Week 3 brings news of a positive Covid test in our Y5 class. A separate letter has been sent to Y5 parents, advising next steps. Please can I remind all parents that if they recognise any of the Coronavirus symptoms in their children or in themselves, (a high temperature, a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours or a loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal), they need to arrange for a PCR test and keep children at home until the results are returned. That way, we are all as safe as we can possibly be and playing our part in looking after each other, also. Many thanks for your full attention to this matter.
