

And finally:-. On Wednesday of this week we celebrate Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the Holy Season of Lent. Traditionally, during this season, people give something up, or take something on, to unite themselves more closely with our Lord during His time of fasting and prayer in the desert. This Lent falls in a year which our Holy Father the Pope has asked to be a special year of prayer in preparation for the Holy Year in 2025. As part of this year of preparation Pope Francis has asked us to focus on the Lord's Prayer, the perfect prayer to the Father given to us by Our Lord Himself. Maybe this Lent, rather that giving something up, we can make a special effort to give a little more of our time to prayer. Perhaps consider attending the Stations of the Cross here in church each week, or coming to the weekly time of Lectio Divina, where we pray with the scriptures – allowing the Word of God to be the inspiration for our prayer.
