Write 5 questions that you could ask, thinking about the events that happened, any feelings they might have had and any other significant details from the story. Remember that some people thought the disciples were drunk on wine. Could this link to one of your questions?</p> <p><b>Part 2:</b> Now, switch roles and put yourself in the shoes of the Apostles. How would you answer the questions you asked?
