And finally:- The celebration of the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which the Church celebrates this Sunday, offers us an opportunity to reflect upon, and give thanks to God for, the day of our own baptism. St. Matthew's account of Christ's baptism in the River Jordan relates how, immediately after He came up out of the waters, the heavens opened and a voice was heard to say "This is my Son, the Beloved, my favour rests on Him". On the day of our baptism maybe our parents and godparents didn't see the heavens open, nor would they have heard the voice of the Father speaking, however, the reality of that moment was identical. As the minister poured water over our heads, as the name of the Most Holy Trinity was invoked, as the Holy Spirit descended, in the silence of our soul's the Father spoke His Word 'You are my beloved son/daughter, my favour rests on you'. May the wonder of this knowledge, that we are the beloved of the Father, fill our hearts and minds each day joy!
