This year the children have voted to support the charities CAFOD, in their initiative to provide urgent food, water and shelter to our global family in Turkey following the earthquake and Father Hudson's Homes, a local based charity.

As part of the children's Lenten initiatives, the Mini Vinnies have voted to carry out two main fundraising initiatives to help both their local and global families.

## Initiative 1 - Family Fast Day

On **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> March** all children will be encouraged to "Live Simply" through their choice of dinner and empathise with their global brothers and sisters, who do not have a lot of food to eat.
