

And finally:- Following the changes in the Covid Guidelines by the government, the Bishops' of England and Wales have now issued new guidance for the celebration of Mass. As of this weekend the wearing of masks at Mass will become completely optional. The Holy Water stoups will be filled and returned to the entrance of the church. Alongside the Hymn Books in the porch the Sunday Missals will also be available for use at the weekend Masses. Whilst the QR Code will remain in place for the 'signing in' at Mass, there will no longer be any need to use the sign in sheet as you come into church. In a few weeks time, once we know how things are going once we have made these changes, the 'sign of peace' will be reintroduced on the First Sunday of Lent. If you are feeling unwell you are encouraged not to attend Mass, however, this is normal practice and I hardly feel the need to make a point of this.
