And finally: Today, with the coming of the Third Sunday of Advent we see a change in the liturgical colour, from Violet to Rose. This momentary change of colour helps to focus our minds, and hearts, on the change in the nature of this Holy Season from today onwards. As we continue our preparations for the Christmas Season, both spiritually and materially, may our hearts be filled with the joy of knowing that God loves us so much that He sent His only begotten Son into our world, that one day we may enter into His eternal Kingdom.
