Key Facts

Aldridge was first recorded as a settlement in 1086 and it was known as "Alrewic".

In the 1800s, Aldridge became an industrial town with coal mines and lime kilns.

During the 20th century, modern shops were built in the centre of Aldridge.

A small airport called Aldridge Airport was used during the Second World War and after was used for passenger services.

Aldridge became an urban district in Staffordshire in 1894. Other villages within the district included Pelsall and Streetly.

Aldridge became part of the Metropolitan Borough of Walsall in 1974.
