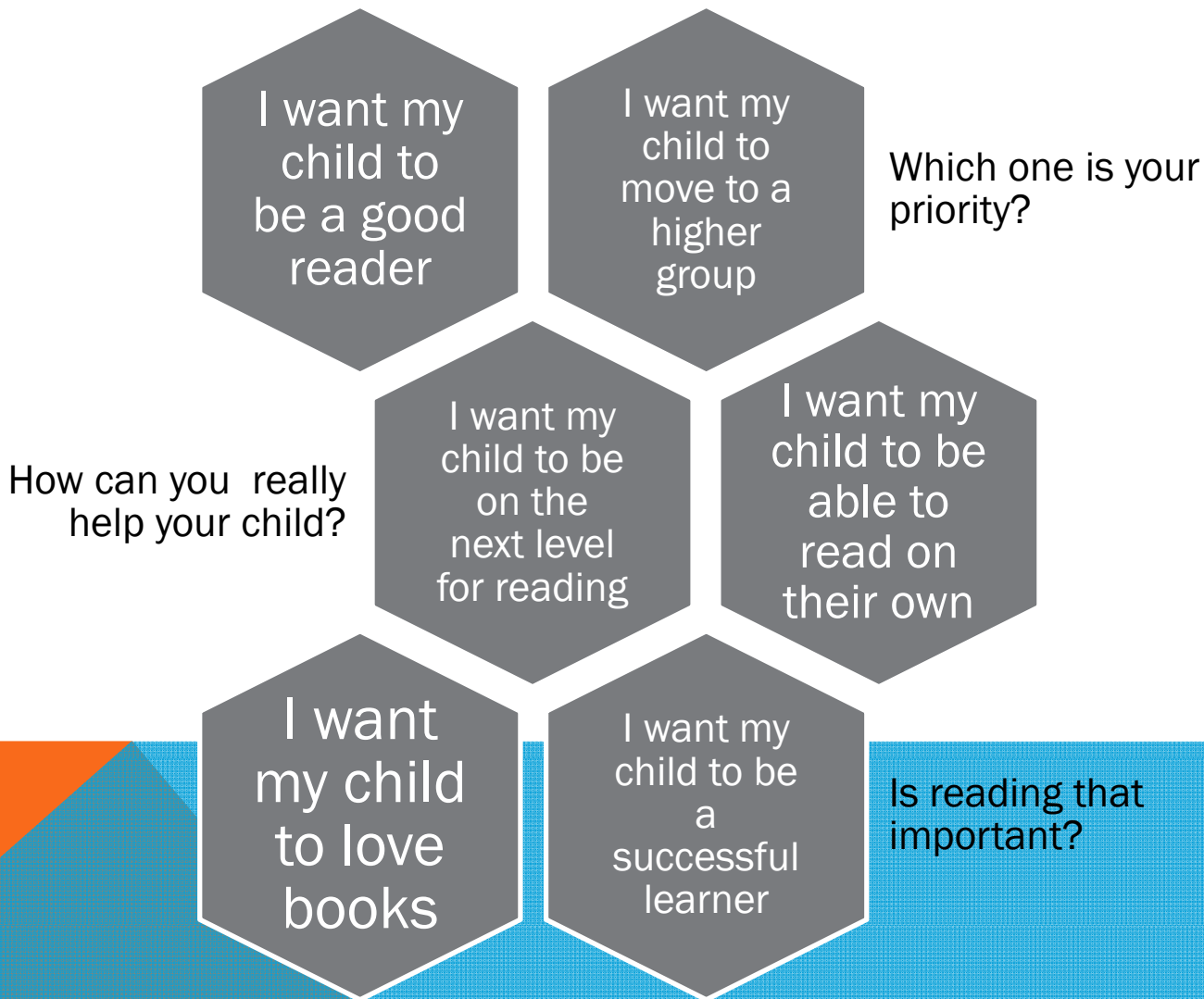

ELEMENTS OF READING IN THE NEW CURRICULUM (AND MOSTLY IN THE OLD!)



Word level (This means the skills of actually reading, spelling and understanding the words).



Comprehension (This means understanding what is meant and why the text is presented that way).



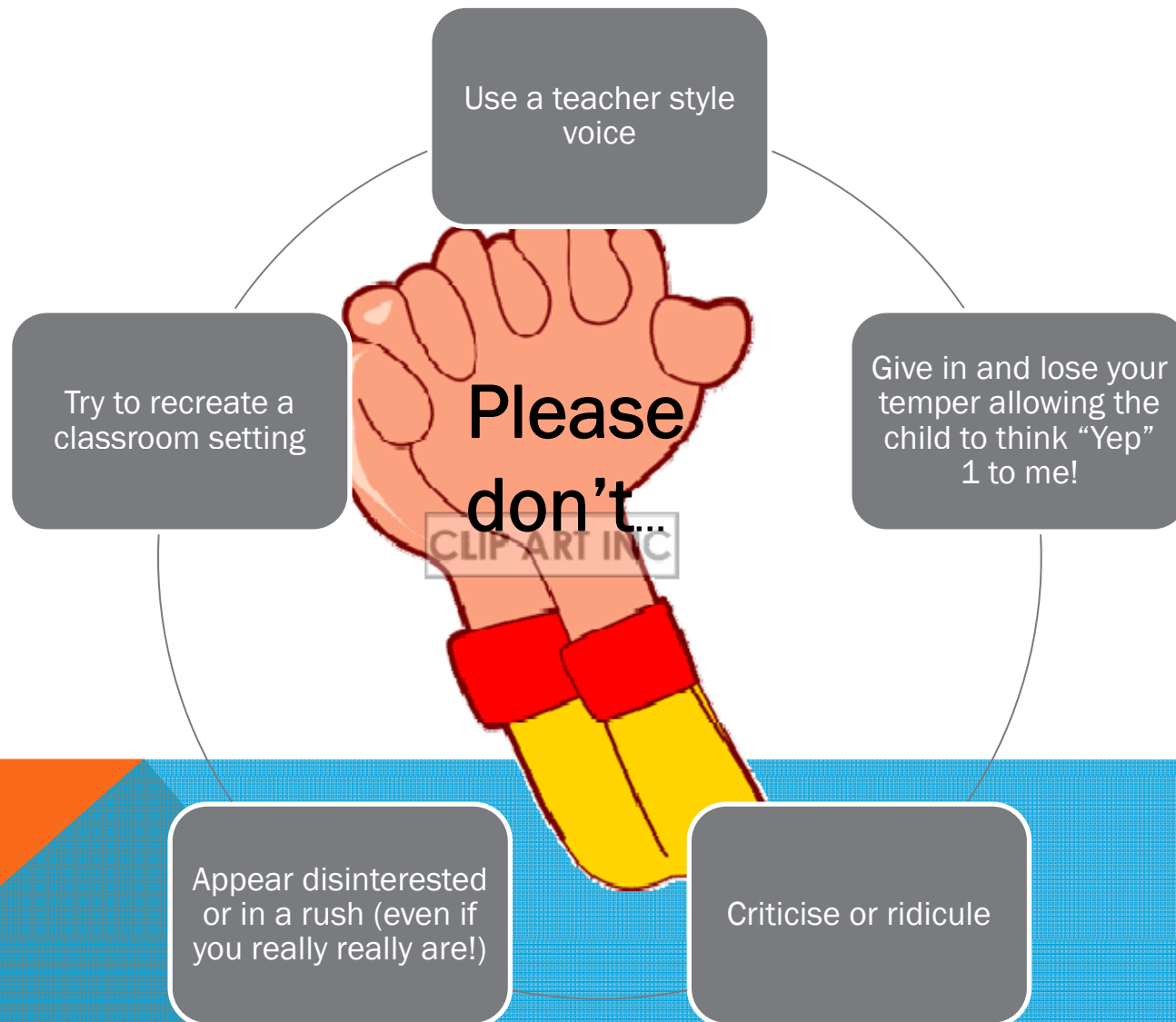
Reading for pleasure.

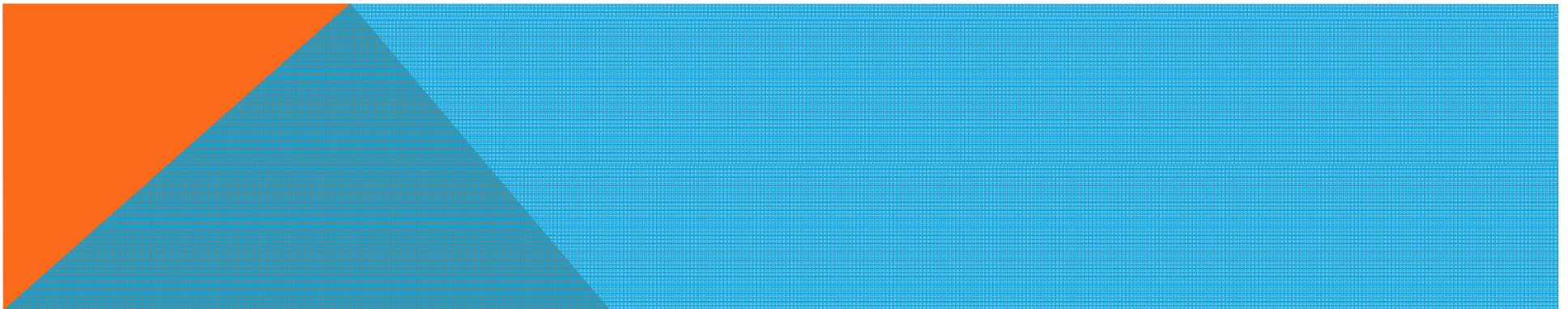

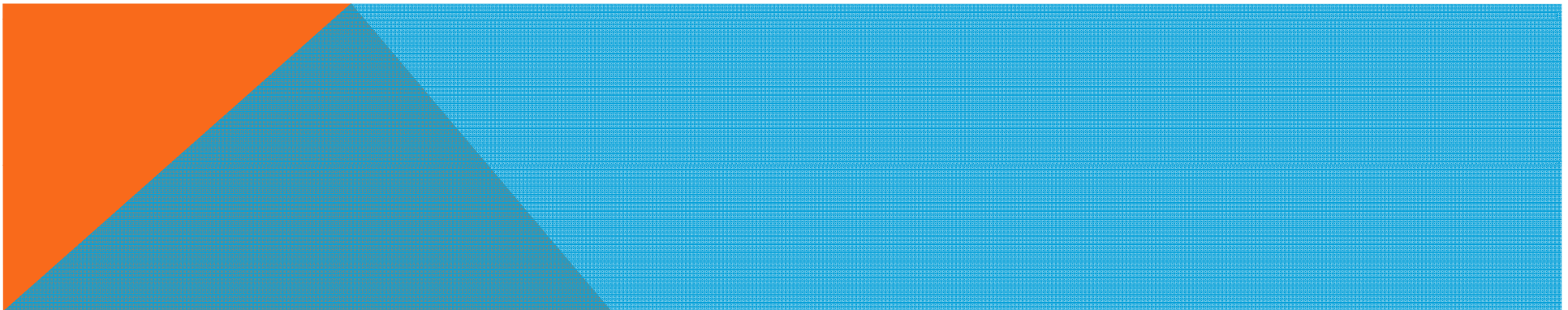

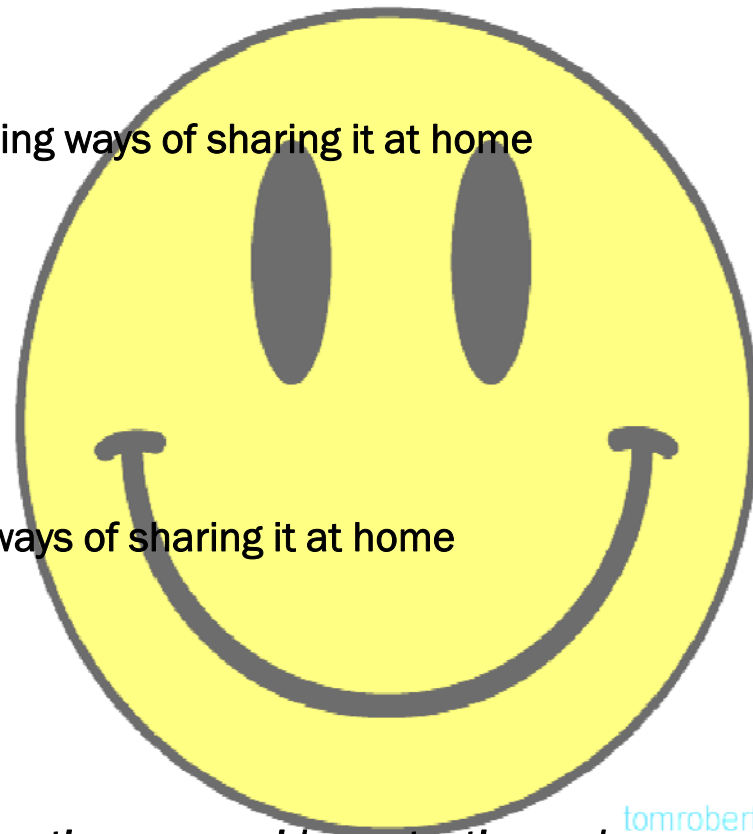
