Baptism and Confirmation are Sacraments through which Christians receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Baptism celebrates the giving of the Holy Spirit and their being welcomed into the Church as the Family of God. The Rite of Baptism includes: The naming of the child. (God calls us by name.) The signing of the cross on the forehead. (Sign of welcome into God's Family and a sign of belonging to Christ.) Laying on of hands and anointing with the Oil of Baptism. (A sign of protection and strengthening the person who is to be baptised.) The Baptismal Promises made by the parents. (Promise to support the person as they grow in faith.) Baptism in water in the name of the Holy Trinity. Anointing with the Oil of Chrism (As a sign that we now belong to Christ and share in his life.) Baptismal Candle presented after being lit from the Paschal Candle. (The light of Christ is now our
