Key Facts

- The Church practice prayer, fasting and almsgiving during the season of Lent. Lent is a season for Christians to pray and fast as Jesus did in the desert and to try and resist temptation to do what is wrong.
- Jesus teaches about forgiveness and this gift is given by God freely through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
- Christians are called to follow Christ by the way they live their lives. The Beatitudes of Jesus provide a guide for this.
- The festival of Yom Kippur, the Jewish Day of Atonement, is a special celebration of forgiveness for the Jewish people.
