## Key Facts

- Baptism and Confirmation are Sacraments through which Christians receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Baptism celebrates the giving of the Holy Spirit and their being welcomed into the Church as the Family of God.  
**The Rite of Baptism includes:**
  - The naming of the child. (God calls us by name.)
  - The signing of the cross on the forehead. (Sign of welcome into God's Family and a sign of belonging to Christ.)
  - Laying on of hands and anointing with the Oil of Baptism. (A sign of protection and strengthening the person who is to be baptised.)
  - The Baptismal Promises made by the parents. (Promise to support the person as they grow in faith.)
- Baptism in water in the name of the Holy Trinity.
- Anointing with the Oil of Chrism (As a sign that we now belong to Christ and share in his life.)
- Baptismal Candle presented after being lit from the Paschal Candle. (The light of Christ is now our guide in life.)  
**Other Sacraments that the Oil of Chrism**
  - The anointing with the Oil of Chrism takes place at the Ordination of a Bishop and Priest.
