And finally:-. Today in the second reading St. Paul speaks of being confident. I hope and pray that this weekend, as we listen to the scriptures, we too become full of confidence as we ponder over the message that they bring. Today we are reminded of God's power; how from things seemingly small and insignificant, a mustard seed and a small shoot, God can do great things. Sometimes as we look around, as we see others who share our faith, we may begin to feel that we have nothing to offer, or that our gifts and talents are nothing in comparison to theirs. Every gift, every talent, no matter how small, can become a roaring fire in the service of the Church if we put it into action, and allow God's grace to give it life.
