Christmas Crib Collection



Throughout the Christmas Season there will be a collection box at the crib for our annual Christmas Crib Collection. This year we are taking this collection to help the work the Father Hudson's Society. Advent and Christmas allow us to reflect on the birth of Jesus and the life and sacrifice he made to lead us in our love and support of our neighbours and those who are strangers to us. Please help Father Hudson's to care for people in need across the Archdiocese of Birmingham.

Sacrament of the Sick

Please remember to inform Fr. Craig directly in case of sickness, especially if it requires hospital treatment or a prolonged absence from Mass. If you cannot inform the clergy yourself it is then your family who should take on this responsibility.

And finally:- On Friday, 17th December, we began to use what have traditionally been called 'The Great O Antiphons'. These seven antiphons, which are used daily from the 17th to the 23rd December as the Magnificat Antiphon at Vespers, and as the Alleluia verse at Mass, are first recorded as being used in the 6th century. Each antiphon beginning with 'O', hence the name, presents us with one of the great Christological titles linking the birth of Christ with the fulfilment of the Messianic prophecies of Isaiah. The usage of these antiphons marks a shift in our Advent focus. In these final days of preparation our focus is moved from looking forwards to Christ's return at the end of time, to His first coming, His birth in the stable at Bethlehem. In these final few days and weeks of Advent, as our preparations for the Christmas festivities intensify with the wrapping of gifts, and the decorating of trees, let us not loose sight of the true meaning of Advent – our watching and waiting for the coming of the Lord. Each day take a few moments to look at the 'O Antiphon' of the day, to pause and reflect upon its meaning, and so prepare our hearts and minds to receive Christ who is: the Morning Star, the Key of David, the Root of Jesse etc.
