Transarent	Transparent objects can be seen through.
Opaque	Opaque objects can be seen through.

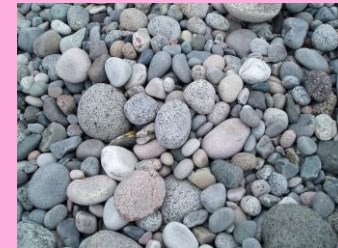

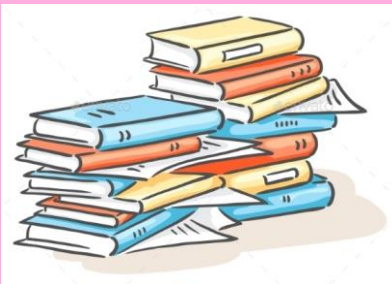
