And finally:- Perhaps the most famous version of the 'Beatitudes' is the one taken from St. Matthew's gospel. Today, however, we read St. Luke's account of the same event. Here we encounter a shorter list of the 'Blessed are...' followed immediately by a list of what it will be like for those whose lives do not conform to these states of 'Blessedness'. Whilst the two accounts of this same event differ they are both conveying to us the same message. As Christians we are called to live our lives in this world as passing pilgrims, making our way by the help of God's grace to our eternal homes in heaven. For us this means that we are to use well the things that are given to us in this life to aid us on our journey, however, we are not to allow ourselves to become so attached to them that we loose sight of our true treasure. It is only when our lives are truly conformed to that of Christ, when we live by the commandment to love God and our neighbour, will we find true happiness in this world.
