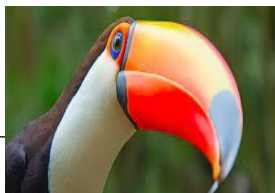

- ✓ Begin to show accuracy and care when drawing.

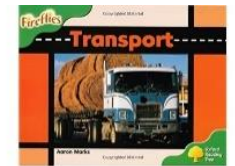
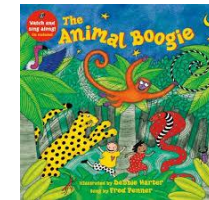
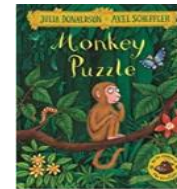


## Links to specific areas

- ✓ Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.
- ✓ Read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.
- ✓ Anticipate - where appropriate, Recall key events in stories,
- ✓ Compose and decompose shapes so that children recognise a shape can have other shapes within it, just as numbers can.
- ✓ how quantities can be distributed equally.
- ✓ Automatically recall number bonds (including subtraction facts) and some number bonds to 10, including double facts.
