



Key Facts

- Jesus is baptised in the River Jordan. He is revealed as the beloved son. This marked the beginning of his ministry
- The signs and symbols of the Rite of Baptism remind us that Christians become the children of God through this Sacrament. They include White Baptismal garment reminding us that we are clothed with God's life. A Baptismal candle reminding us that we live in the light of Christ. The Oil of Chrism reminding us that we are anointed to live like Jesus. The giving of a Christian name reminding us that we are called by name to belong to God's family.
