

And finally:-. A few weeks ago, in his Pastoral Letter, His Grace the Archbishop spoke of his desire that each Deanery of the Archdiocese should establish a 'Deanery Pastoral Council'. For many years the Walsall Deanery had an 'Area Pastoral Council' which helped the clergy in the decision making, and also arranged events such as the Eucharistic procession through the streets of Walsall. For several months now the clergy of the newly established Walsall and Lichfield Deanery have been discussing the reestablishment of this council. Each parish has been asked to provide two representatives who would be willing to serve as members. It is envisaged that there will only be two or three meetings per year and one AGM. Its work will be to help the clergy to co-ordinate work amongst the parishes of the Deanery, and to help forward the Diocesan Pastoral Vision. I am therefore asking for two volunteers who would be willing to join in this important work. If you would like to join please could you see me as soon as is possible.
