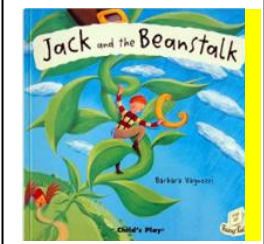
A	Capital letters for sentences, initials and proper nouns.

Key vocabulary

Sentence - capital letter, finger spaces, full stops and makes sense.

Conjunctions: words that join two statements (joining words) - and, but, so, because

Caption - short explanation next to a picture

Question - a sentence asking something

Headline - a heading at the top of an article in a newspaper or magazine.

Report -giving a written account of something that someone has seen or observed.

Reporter - a person who reports the news.
