
62 families responded, representing 40% of the school population. Here are a sample of the findings for your information.

Question: The school provision understands that my child needs a good routine, which works around my work needs too.


The pre recorded teachers' videos allow me to work with my child when I can.


Question: Work provided includes Maths, English, R.E and Wlder learning (History, Art, P.E, story, dance etc).

Question: My child is being guided to know what they should be doing to make their work better, via the pre-recorded videos and communication about self-assessment (yes yellow).



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
62 families responded, representing 40% of the school population. Here are a sample of the findings for your information.


1= All of the time- 5= Not at all




Question: My child's spiritual life and wellbeing is being addressed by the Remote Learning Provision as part of their curriculum entitlement.

Summary Feedback Spring 2021- A flavour of the comments shared and our responses to them

Thank you for all of the hard work that is going into remote learning. I really appreciate how personalised it is and the feedback given. The flexibility to access it a later time/day is really useful too.

Thank you

Would be good (if possible) if the school could arrange a zoom call with all the children so they can see each other. One of the parents arranged this for their child's birthday recently and it was good to see them. While at home, our son doesn't get to see anyone and I feel he misses the lack of interaction with his friends – just an idea for the future.

Thank you- we did. It was great to see almost everyone there

You are all doing an amazing job! We hope school can recommence when it is safe to do so, but feel happy with home schooling this time round. Videos each day help us as parents to understand what/how we need to teach each subject (which is a god send!). If school does not open until September (hopefully it will) we are happy to carry on home schooling this way (but, may be a chocoholic by then!) If it keeps everyone safe and learning as best as we can.

The pre-recorded videos are much easier for us all as a family and I think this provides a good routine with both of my children being able to see their teachers on a daily basis. Much improved method of reaching the children and allowing us as parents to see the current methods of teaching as opposed to methods we were taught many years ago.

We've been really pleased with the setup for the home learning this time around and the children love to see their teachers. They are doing an amazing job, thank you. One thing that could be helpful is for resources to be accessible in advance (some are) to allow for preparation etc. We understand the videos not being on in advance and that's nice as teachers are referring to pupils' work, but if the teachers have the weekly planning, perhaps the resources could be shared? Overall, we are really pleased and everything is personal and well prepared. Thank you to all staff who are working so hard.

I think the videos and work set are excellent and they allow my daughter to work at her own pace with our support. Very pleased. Thank you

The class videos are great, my child is more engaged seeing her teacher and having her talk through the work. She gets feedback daily which gives her a little buzz and encourages her to get on and do her work. The only time she's not liked it was when her class mates were included in the video, she does miss them and was a little jealous I think, but ok when I explained why they were there. Thank you

I'm hoping that there will be provisions in place for when she returns that will help her get back up to speed

A natural worry after what we have been through. There will be ongoing assessments and parents will be contacted regularly, as needed.

To further promote the physical and wellbeing of a child it would be good to include an activity that can be done away from the screen- so adding in PE time in the class

We agree- screen time is an issue, nationally. We also cannot wait for a return to normal P.E in school. In the meantime, we have added additional outdoor times each morning

Would like a more specific idea of how well my child is doing in comparison to others so I know whether I'm on the right track. Working and trying to teach I have to divide my time and if my child is falling behind I'd like to know so I can dedicate more time.

Thank you- we did send out some positive emails just to reassure you. We intend to continue this positive feedback whilst being mindful of staff feedback

We think that class video calls through Microsoft teams and other similar portal would definitely help and would be a way forward. We find it challenging to teach the children ourselves and is better handled by professionals like teachers Thank you- each school needed to make a best fit decision. So ours was to provide the pre-recorded videos which recognised the nature of the children here at St Mary's.

I'm so proud of how well my children have adapted to home schooling. I do know, as do my children, that they try harder for their teachers than they do for me, at home. But they are working hard and we have extra fun when they have off days. The teachers are doing an amazing job, we are very proud of them.

We are proud of you all, too.

Our child thoroughly enjoys the videos and the learning and they work perfectly for us as a family because due to working, we often support our child's home learning on the evenings or at weekends.

The class page is great for uploading work and receiving feedback! Our child loves receiving the messages from his teacher.

Thank you. It is a two-way process- teachers love hearing from the children too.

Having the ability to read comments from teachers with regards to the work submitted, keeps parents more informed with their child's progress than they would normally be during a school term, feedback would only usually be received at parents evening. Seeing what the teachers are feeding back is a useful guide to enable us to help our child better with her work. The layout is clear and easy to use, at a glance it is clear what work has been submitted and what is left to complete. All very user friendly.

Great to hear!

The videos are brilliant so interactive, very clear, we don't always get round to uploading homework and do the work at different times but it's great to have it there to refer to. **We fully understand and are glad that you are adapting provision to your own needs.**

Remote learning during the first lockdown was very challenging as we had no clue how to teach certain subjects. Although the kids are at school now, we have accessed the online materials for some of the days when they were at home. We found the videos really helpful both for us and the children

Thank you

When introducing new work that they have not done before, I think more time is needed to explain it to the children.

Thank you- we agree and look forward to being able to teach properly again. In the meantime, a message via the class page usually alerts the teacher to a specific need.

The provision of pre-printed school packs for the forthcoming week would be useful
